Ho`omalua O Na Kamali`i

A partnership including **Family Programs Hawai`i**, major donor Mike Wood and his family, the Department of Human Services, and other community groups, is opening a shelter in Ma`ili for children from the Leeward Coast entering the child welfare system. The receiving home, named **Ho`omalua O Na Kamali`i**, is currently under construction and is scheduled to open by Spring of 2009.

The home will accommodate 15 children, up to 17 years of age and will provide 24/7 staffing, access to social workers and other health professionals, and all the amenities of home. Most children will be able to remain in their own school while their needs are assessed and they are transitioned into safe and loving permanent homes. The home will rely heavily on community volunteers and support.



Community members can support this safe haven for children one brick at a time. For a donation of \$200, you can buy a brick inscribed with your name or message, to be built into the walkway of the home. Your tax deductible donation will create a lasting imprint of your commitment to keeping Hawai`i's children safe.

Individuals, groups, companies and families may purchase bricks to help fund shelter operations. Here are some ideas for buying bricks.
